These internationally recognised standards help us work more efficiently, meet legal standards and improve how we operate every day. They mark a significant milestone in our commitment to continually improving services for local government partners and communities across Australia.

Resource Recovery Australia operates across 14 waste management facilities nationwide. We operate Community Recycling Centres, Reviva Reuse Shops, The Tinkering workshops and manage transfer stations, weighbridges and landfills in partnership with local councils, supporting the community to divert significant amounts of waste from landfills. These facilities enable us to repurpose materials, manage waste efficiently, and provide jobs to those facing barriers to employment, enhancing environmental sustainability and community outcomes.

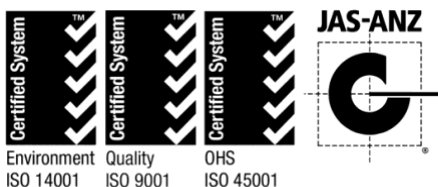
